## Volunteers are needed to help with a variety of activities and committees:

Please check those activities or committees you would be interested in helping with.

- Membership—1-2 persons needed to start pta membership drive and collect/organize member data for PTA/school use (Sept-Nov—apprx 4 hrs/mth)
- Fall Fundraiser—1-2 persons needed to coordinate with Club Choice to kickoff our main fundraiser and collect/organize/count orders (Sept—apprx. 4 hours)
- Magazine Fundraiser—1-2 persons to organize, kickoff and collect orders—(apprx 8-10 hrs)
- Spring Fundraiser—see fall fundraiser (Apprx 4 hrs)
- Fun Night Coordinators—Annual end of year carnival. 1-2 persons to organize annual outdoor event (May event, apprx 60 Hours)
- Relay Editor—1-2 persons to publish quarterly newsletter (apprx. 2-4 hrs/qtr)
- Yearbook—1-2 persons to work with 5th grade teachers/students in creating the annual yearbook. (apprx 100 Hrs)
- Social—1-2 persons to coordinate conference night teacher dinners, Fun Nite concessions, sitters for PTA, etc. (all year—apprx 1-6 hrs/mth)
- Random Acts of Kindness (RAK)-1-2 persons to recognize staff during the year (para week, health week, etc.)(all year—apprx 1-4 hrs/mth)
- Club Coordinator—1-2 persons to help with coordination of existing clubs and creation of new clubs for students [new position-replaces Education Coor.]
- Family events coordinator—1-2 persons to coordinate family events: skate nights, bike rodeo, dinner & book nights, talent show, etc. [new position]
- Label's fundraiser coordinator-1-2 persons to coordinate, collect and turn in soup labels, boxtops, etc. (apprx 1-4 hrs/mth)
- Student Directory coordinator—1-2 persons to coordinate with school to publish student directory (Sept/Oct—apprx 8-12 hrs)
- Room Parent coordinator—1-2 persons to use parent volunteer signup data and make sure each classroom has a room parent w/volunteer interest list (Sept—apprx 6-12 hrs)
- Gift to Randolph committee—3-5 persons to explore options for playground improvement (present to PTA Oct meeting)

### Other volunteer opportunities:

- Fun Night volunteer (help at the event, 1/2 hr to 1 hr shifts, event runs 5:00 to 8:00)
- Classroom volunteer
- Book Fair volunteer
- Family events volunteer
